FOR OUR UNION ELECTION AT AA!

On Tuesday, May 28 we filed for our election at the NMB to become Teamsters.

Many months of hard work by rank-and-file AA mechanics and the support of the Teamsters has led us to this point. We have reached a huge milestone in our campaign to secure our future as Teamster mechanics and related at AA.

- After decades of concessionary bargaining, lost jobs and declining standards, we will soon have an opportunity to vote in the Teamsters, a union with an unbeatable record when it comes to protecting our craft against outsourcing, restoring lost jobs and raising standards for mechanics in our industry. As Teamsters, we'll have the power of the largest aircraft mechanics union fighting for us at the bargaining table and on the shop floor every day.

The TWU has proven that it is far too weak to give us the representation we deserve at AA, much less the representation we need at the new American Airlines.
