STAND UP FOR PUBLIC SAFETY

We believe Chief Judge Clancy Boles is violating Illinois' state labor laws, and is determined to destroy the longstanding pay system for Kane County's probation officers and youth counselors. Her actions may have compromised the public safety and forced these dedicated criminal justice workers to strike in protest of her attacks on their jobs.

The County recently cut spending on public safety and eliminated programs to monitor dangerous criminals awaiting trial. Now, after four weeks without these important Kane County criminal justice workers, there are an estimated 3,000 criminal offenders not being supervised by the same professional probation officers. The list of offenders includes approximately150 sex offenders and 100 high-risk offenders.

This problem continues because Chief Judge Clancy Boles refuses to honor the longstanding pay systems for the dedicated probation officers and youth counselors who serve as one of the last lines of defense against crime in our communities.

Statistics don't lie. Felony crime cases are surging in Kane County. Now Kane County's probation officers and youth counselors have walked off their jobs in protest over Chief Judge Clancy Boles' efforts to gut important longstanding pay provisions from their labor contract.

The County recently cut spending on public safety and eliminated programs designed to monitor dangerous criminals awaiting trial. Now approximately 150 sex offenders and 100 high risk offenders are not being supervised by the same, highly trained, and professional probation officers who are on strike.

If that weren't bad enough, the County Board is sitting on their hands while Chief Judge Susan Clancy Boles has refused to make any improved offer to end the unfair labor practice strike.

Therefore, we urge you to work together to ensure that your veteran probation officers and youth counselors have the resources, support, and leadership they need and deserve.
