Dear Bauer's IT drivers,

In Silicon Valley and around the nation, the Rainbow PUSH Coalition has fought for economic justice, fairness and workers' right to organize. From bus drivers to security officers, working people are rallying, and winning in Silicon Valley.

You may remember that Dr. King's last campaign was in support of striking sanitation workers in Memphis who were seeking union recognition. He believed then, as we do today, that the right to unionize is central to the quest for economic and social justice.

For the past few years, the Rainbow PUSH Coalition has been at the forefront of the battle against income inequality in Silicon Valley. And while many have amassed tremendous profits, unfortunately too many workers of color have not shared in that wealth. Your efforts to unionize will be a major step in combatting the income inequality gap and affording working families with some measure of economic justice.

In seeking to unionize, you are demanding your fair share of the tremendous wealth creation in Silicon Valley, and you are winning. Your vote to join the Teamsters union will be part of that history, just as the milestones of past struggles are remembered.
