The following is a list of improvements in the Joint Collective Bargaining Agreement by Article. There are many changes to all three agreements and this list is only meant as a brief summary.

#### Article 1 - Scope

- Addition of the Flight Simulator Technician Craft
- Improved definition of "previously contracted out work"
- Addition of attrition protection
- Base protection for SFO and Houston Maintenance Facilities
- Protections if ALPA pilots fly the aircraft IBT mechanics fix them

#### Article 3 – Classifications

- · Reduction of time to qualify for lead in most bid areas
- Addition of Flight Sim Techs
- Addition of Maintenance Planning Analysts

#### Article 4 – Seniority

- Clarification of Furlough Recall Date
- Elimination of 30 day leave accrual

## Article 5 – Filling of Vacancies

· Members fill vacancies prior to outside groups in a defined order

#### Article 6 – RIF and Recall

- Clarification of the process
- Clarification of the Station/Points

#### Article 7 – Hours of Service

- Clarification of Fixed and Rotating Day patterns
- Improvement of lunch on "any" shift
- Clarification on Day Trades

#### Article 8- Holidays

- All members receive 10 Holidays
- Clarification of Holiday off request

#### Article 9 - Vacation

- Improved Vacation accrual schedule
- Clarification of DAT openings during a Vacation period
- Improved ability to transfer Vacation time to sick bank or 401(k) in year of retirement

#### Article 10 - Leaves of Absence

- Seniority accrual on Extended Illness Status
- Vacation accrual on EIS if off because of a work related injury
- Number of Emergency Leaves increased to 2 in special circumstances
- Two years of benefits eligibility on EIS

#### Article 11 – Sick Leave

- 100% pay for sick leave
- Employees with greater than 700 hours occupational time grandfathered

Clarification of light duty overtime

#### Article 12 - Field Trips

- Clarification of those jobs that require travel
- · Better definition of planned and unplanned field trips
- Better defined call out procedure
- Definition of amount of time before list must be called

#### Article 13 – Training

- Bypass in Training will not be allowed to be used to bypass member for overtime or field trip except for defined exclusions
- Clarification of bidding for full time training positions

#### Article 15 – Compensation

• One time paid career move

- 28% increase to Technician rates
- \$1.20 per hour HRA/VEBA for up to 2080 hours annually
- A&P License pay \$5.25
- FCC License pay \$4.00
- Line pay \$1.00

- Retirement plan with final average earnings 1.19% rate
- Increased pension for those on Guam
