



## **8-HOUR REQUESTS**

Our new contract reduces the notice required for an 8-hour request from 5 calendar days to **3 workdays**. It also **doubles the penalty** for an 8-hour request violation from 2 hours straight time to 2 hours at double time. And **UPS is required to adjust a driver's dispatch <u>before</u> start time.** 

"...management shall have the responsibility to make the necessary arrangement to ensure the driver is off in the requested eight (8) hours." (Article 37, Section 1b)

- **3** Request submitted at least **THREE** workdays from requested day.
- **2 TWO** fulfilled 8-hour requests allowed each month.
- 1 Management must make further adjustment to your load if you notify them by 1:00 pm that you cannot complete.

UPS is required to approve **10 percent** of the 8-hour requests from all drivers in a center on a given day.

UPS doesn't care about your time. As Teamsters, we don't have to worry about what management cares about – because we have a strong contract. But the contract only works when we enforce it.
