### **United Airlines Bargaining Update: Progress at the Table**

The Teamsters National Negotiating Committee for United Airlines is in Boston this week to continue bargaining. In just the first two days of this session, significant progress has been made — including narrowed down discussions on wages.

Over the last several months, members have submitted comments to the Airline Division suggesting changes needed to be made to our negotiating process to move things along. We heard that feedback, and have acted accordingly this week.

We are happy to report that the changes that have been made have already delivered significant progress so far, including three proposal passes between the committee and the company just today — the most to be passed in a single day of negotiating since we began bargaining.

While negotiations are ongoing, members may hear unofficial reports circulating about proposals or discussions at the table. Information shared outside of official bargaining updates often reflects incomplete details or personal interpretations and emotions rather than the full facts of negotiations. Members should rely on official updates from the Airline Division for the most accurate information about the status of bargaining.

Teamsters leadership will continue pushing forward at the table and will keep members informed as negotiations progress this week.
