Negotiations Advance with Economics and Scope Passes

The Teamsters National Negotiating Committee for United Airlines made more progress at the table this week, passing both economic and scope proposals to the company. These proposals reflect the priorities members have identified throughout negotiations and represent important steps in advancing discussions on some of the most critical parts of the agreement.

The committee also held firm on arbitration-related issues. While resolutions were reached in areas where agreement was possible, we maintained our position on matters we believe to have merit. Ultimately, the company agreed that it was more important to continue moving negotiations forward than to allow outstanding disputes to stall progress.

Scope discussions remain ongoing, and the company will pass their counters to these proposals when the committee reconvenes in Denver on May 5.
